



Addendums to the Arnot Ogden Medical Center School of Nursing 's Two-Year Associated Degree in Nursing (RN) Program

Effective: 2/18/26

CRITERIA FOR ACCEPTANCE INCLUDES:

- Proof of high school graduation or high school equivalency completion.
- *If the applicant is currently in high school: Grades of "C" or above for courses in Algebra, Biology and Chemistry. **Biology requirement** is waived for non-traditional students.*
- *Or if applicant did not complete Chemistry and/or algebra in high school, completion of college level Chemistry (grade of C or higher) and/or completion of high school level algebra (grade C or higher).*
- *Completion of the ATI TEAS exam (Test of Essential Academic Skills) with a combined score equal to or greater than the National Mean (64.9% currently).
- Obtaining the minimum score of 15 for non-traditional and 12 for current high school seniors for acceptance on the "admission score card"

TRANSFER CREDITS POLICY

The applicant must submit an official transcript from each institution attended as a requirement for admission. Each transcript is evaluated on an individual basis and coursework is evaluated for possible transfer of credits. Coursework considered for transfer include Anatomy & Physiology I & II (8 credits total), ~~Chemistry (4 credits)~~, and Microbiology (4 credits). . Science coursework, A&P 1 & 2 (must be completed at the same school) and microbiology will not be considered if more than 5 years have past since their completion. **Previously completed nursing courses are not eligible for transfer credit.**

TUITION AND FEES ACADEMIC YEAR 2025-26

For your information these are expenses you will incur before you start classes and will not be covered by financial aid.

Additional fees:

- *Elmira College requires a \$150 fee prior to room assignment, which will be credited to room bill.*
- *The School of Nursing requires a \$150 deposit upon acceptance, which is applied to the tuition bill.*
- *Travel and field trip expenses are additional.*
- *Students must carry hospitalization insurance comparable to coverage available to Arnot Ogden Medical Center employees.*
- *The AOMC SON does require the students to have a compatible laptop prior to the start of school. The AOMC SON also has compatible laptops available for student use in emergent situations. Chromebooks are incompatible with utilized classroom software. IPADS and tablets are not preferred due to online testing requirements.*
- *CastleBranch background check approx. \$145*
- *Uniforms (2) approx.. \$75 each*
- *Shoes and Stethoscope prices vary*
- *Elmira College books and materials prices vary*
